

**Catawba County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC)**  
**Request for Additional Proposals: Fiscal Year 2017**

The Catawba JCPC requests proposals to serve delinquent and at risk youth, ages 6 – 17, from local non-profits, public agencies, and housing authorities. Approximately \$12,945\* remaining through NC Department of Public Safety – Division of Adult Correction/Juvenile Justice for fiscal year July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. JCPC funding requires a 30% local match.

Funding priority will be given to proposals for the following service types:

Psychological services/comprehensive assessments; Counseling; Restitution/Community Service; Substance Abuse assessment and treatment; Mentoring; Family Skill building; Group Home/Residential services; Interpersonal Skill building; Mediation; Sexual Offender assessment and treatment; Temporary Shelter; Therapeutic Foster Care; Tutoring; Structured Day; Experiential; Teen Court; and Vocational programs.

Service programming should be designed to reduce one or more of the following priority risk and needs factors:

Risks: Number of undisciplined or delinquent referrals at intake; Known use of alcohol or illegal drugs; School behavior problems; Relationship with peers; Parental supervision; Needs: Peer relationships; School behavior/adjustment; Substance use within the last 12 months; Sexual behaviors within the past 12 months; Mental health needs; Basic physical needs/Independent living; Conflict in the home within the past 12 months; Family supervision skills; Family substance abuse within the past three years by household member; and Family criminality.
