in celebration of America Recycles Day**

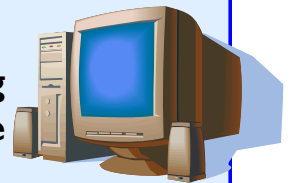
The first 200 people that bring plastic bags to recycle will receive a reusable bag!
