

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
February 13, 2024


Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15am. The minutes from the February 6 meeting were approved unanimously.

61 absentee ballot applications were approved unanimously, with two being from overseas, 47 CIV applications with completed acceptable ID exception forms (including one which had been rejected at the last meeting for an incomplete form), and 12 CIV applications with ID

Director Amanda Duncan reported that a question had been raised about whether open or concealed firearms were permitted at election sites. For locations on government-owned property, firearms are not permitted. For privately owned sites, Duncan will ask representatives for each host location about their preferences on the subject prior to the November election.

There being no other items of business, Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
