

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
October 1, 2024

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15 am.

The Board unanimously approved the minutes from the meeting of July 31, 2024.

The Board then unanimously approved absentee ballot applications. There were 14 civilian, 60 overseas and 16 military.

Director Amanda Duncan presented a proposed slate of judges for the five early voting locations. These were approved unanimously. She also presented wording to be used at early voting sites to provide the choice to voters as to whether to use the ExpressVote machine to print a marked paper ballot or whether to receive a blank paper ballot to be marked manually. The Board unanimously approved the proposed language with one additional phrase to clarify that in the first option, the machine will "print a marked paper ballot."

There being no other items of business, Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
