

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
November 5, 2024

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

The Board unanimously approved the minutes from the meeting of November 4, 2024.

Director Amanda Duncan reported that one additional voter had passed away since casting an early ballot. A letter regarding the Board's challenge to that vote will be sent to the last known addresses for the voter, with the hearing to take place at Canvass.

The Board then reviewed and certified the absentee ballot tabulation, and then executed abstracts for submission to the State Board of Elections.

Chair Cheney reported that a photograph had been received showing a flag posted at an election-day voting location which looked very similar to the color and format of a flag flown by supporters of a particular candidate. The Board unanimously agreed to ask Director Duncan to contact the representatives of that polling location to inform them that such a voting location cannot be perceived as supporting or opposing any particular candidate, and to refrain from such a display in the future.

There being no other items of business, Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
