

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
November 14, 2024

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15 am. Member Culbreath-Setzer was not in attendance.


The Board unanimously approved the minutes from the meeting of November 5, 2024.

The Board then unanimously approved supplemental absentee ballots, those received by election day. There were 114 civilian, another 65 civilian with approved ID exception forms, 5 overseas and 9 military.

Director Amanda Duncan then reported on the total of 571 submitted provisional ballots. After review of the provisional application envelopes by the Board members in attendance, the Board unanimously approved 213 provisionals to be counted in full, 3 to be partially counted for the races available to those voters on the ballot styles submitted, and unanimously rejected another 330 provisional ballots because those voters were not registered. Another 25 provisionals remain in pending status, since those voters have until 5pm on November 14 to satisfy the Voter ID requirements for their votes to count. The status of those provisionals shall be determined at canvass.

There being no other items of business, Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
