Saturday	October 18	CLOSED
Sunday	October 19	CLOSED
Monday – Friday	October 20-24	8am–5pm
Saturday	October 25	CLOSED
Sunday	October 26	CLOSED
Monday – Friday	October 27-October 31	8am–5pm
Saturday	November 1	8am–3pm

If you are not registered, you may register and vote only at a Early Voting site with proof of residency

(see back of this sheet for Proof of Residence Documents).

**Buffer zones:** are designated by NCGS

§163-166.4: "...the county board of elections shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed..."

## Acceptable Photo IDs for Voting

(All voters must show Photo ID)

**Any of the following that is unexpired, or expired for one year or less\*:**

- North Carolina driver's license
- State ID from the NCDMV (also called "non-operator ID")
- Driver's license or non-driver ID from another state, District of Columbia or U.S. territory (only if voter registered in North Carolina within 90 days of the election)
- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport card
- North Carolina voter photo ID card issued by a county board of elections
- College or university student ID approved by the State Board of Elections (Lenoir Rhyne University IDs have been approved)
- State or local government or charter school employee ID approved by the State Board of Elections

*\*Note: A voter 65 or older may use an expired form of acceptable ID if the ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday.*

**Any of the following, regardless of whether the ID contains an expiration or issuance date:**

- Military or veterans ID card issued by the U.S. government
- Tribal enrollment card issued by a tribe recognized by the State or federal government
- ID card issued by an agency of the U.S. government or the State of North Carolina for a public assistance program

## Proof of Residence

(When Registering and Voting at the same time)

**If the Photo ID does not have the current residence address, additional proof will be required:**

A recent document showing the voter's name and current address (dated within the past 3 months):

- utility bill (including mobile service providers)
- paycheck from an employer
- private bank statement
- property tax statement issued by a governmental agency
- vehicle registration issued by a governmental agency
- government check, including any Social Security, employment, pension, benefit, or reimbursement check from any government entity
- government invoice, statement, or receipt
- public housing identification card, lease, or rental statement
- public educational institution documents, including any student card, transcript, tuition statement, invoice, or receipt issued by any public educational institution
- government insurance plan card, drug discount card, or drug prescription issued by a government care facility (including military facilities)
- discharge certificates, pardons, or other government documents issued in connection with the resolution of a criminal case, indictment, sentence, or other matter
- public transportation authority cards, invoices, receipts or correspondence
- public assistance or disability agency documents
- documents issued by any government shelter, or temporary/transitional housing facility
- drug prescription issued by a government doctor or other governmental health care provider
- college and university roster used in conjunction with school photo ID
