Resolution County of Catawba State of North Carolina

Whereas, the Catawba County Board of Elections will be conducting the Municipal Election on November 4, 2025, and,

Whereas, the following precincts have the listed number of eligible voters:

Precinct 9 ----- 459 voters
Precinct 21 ----- 12 voters
Precinct 23 ----- 570 voters
Precinct 24 ----- 239 voters
Precinct 27 ----- 142 voters
Precinct 33 ----- 503 voters

Whereas, GS 163-128 (a) permits voters to be temporarily transferred, for the purpose of voting, to an adjacent precinct

Whereas, after reviewing the number of registered voters in the above listed precincts, the Board of Elections determined that:

1. the number of voters in some of the precincts are not sufficient to justify the opening of these precincts for this election,
2. the voters in these selected precincts will be notified, individually by first class mail, to vote in the below listed precincts for this election only, and
3. the county board of election will maintain separate registration and voting records so as to properly identify the precinct in which such voters reside.

Therefore, Be It Unanimously Resolved by the Catawba County Board of Election that for the Municipal only, the following eligible voters will be temporarily transferred to vote in the following precincts:

Precinct # 9 eligible voters will vote at precinct #20.
Precinct # 21 eligible voters will vote at precinct # 5.
Precinct# 23 eligible voters will vote at precinct# 4.
Precinct# 24 eligible voters will vote at precinct # 4.
Precinct# 27 eligible voters will vote at precinct # 6.
Precinct# 33 eligible voters will vote at precinct# 7.

Be It Further Resolved that the Board of Elections shall submit this resolution to the State Board of Elections for its approval.
