

MINUTES OF  
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
April 19, 2005

Chairman Bob Johnson called the meeting to order. Larry Brewer reported that he had completed a large number of conversations with Hickory and the other cities regarding early voting arrangements for both the Hickory Primary and General Election in November. At this point, based upon opposition of the City of Hickory and others, we will not have a second early voting site in Hickory but instead will have only one site in Newton for the November election. For the Hickory Primary in October, the law requires there to be at least one early voting site. We are waiting to hear back from the City of Hickory on whether to put that site in Hickory or in Newton. Warren Wood is the contact person at Hickory with whom Larry Brewer has been dealing. Larry will tell the cities that the early voting site will have ten people trained overall, with about six to eight on average present at any one time during the process.

Larry Brewer reported that we are unlikely to be a test county for the new state concept of voting centers rather than precincts, since this is likely to cost more money and thus will not be approved by the County.

The Board discussed the voting location at Precinct 38. Northminster Presbyterian had sent a letter to the County Commissioners protesting the move of the voting location to Lakeview Baptist, and saying that they were expecting to get the precinct location back after their renovations were complete. David Hood reported that he went to talk to the Northminster Presbyterian minister, to explain to him that indeed the Board did not get sufficient notice from Northminster last year before the July election. Since the Board had to find a voting location on almost no notice, it was not true that Northminster was keeping the Board informed regarding their progress. Although there are some advantages to moving the location back to Northminster, particularly given the fact that the precinct has voted at that location for a long time, the Board agreed to keep the precinct location at

Lakeview Baptist since it would be difficult to justify removing the location after Lakeview Baptist had been so gracious to accept us on such short notice last year. Allen Wood will draft a letter to this effect, to be signed by Chairman Johnson.

The county has indicated that the lines on election day should move quicker. The Board authorized to test lap top registration procedures, as opposed to using the traditional books, in two precincts during the November election. Chairman Johnson then adjourned the meeting.

July 28, 2005

Chairman Bob Johnson called the meeting to order. The Board approved a resolution on early voting for the 2005 election including the dates and times, and detailed information regarding location. This resolution will be sent to the State Board for approval.

Larry Brewer reported that there was no State Board Of Election appointed as of yet, so no new County Board has been appointed either. We will have to meet no later than August 16 to appoint our precinct workers, even if there is still no new County Board of Elections. The Board agreed to go ahead and appoint precinct workers by then on the grounds that the present County Board of Elections stays in place until the new one is appointed.

The Board has set tentative precinct worker training dates beginning September 28 for the Hickory Primary and October 24 for the general election. Many precincts will not be open in November due to the lack of municipal races in those precincts. In addition, we will move relevant voters from Precincts 23 and 24 to vote at the Precinct 4 location, voters at 29 to vote at the Precinct 30 location, and voters at 9 to vote at the Precinct 20 location. Larry Brewer reported that both party chairs are working on lists of precinct workers for the 2005 elections.

The Board agreed to meet August 16 at 8 a.m. to appoint precinct workers. Chairman Johnson then adjourned the meeting.
