Newly appointed members Allen Wood, David Hood, and Berry Cheney were sworn in by Catawba County Register of Deeds Donna Spencer. The Board then voted unanimously to appoint Allen Wood as chairman and David Hood as Secretary.

The Board unanimously approved a list of the duties of Larry Brewer as Elections Director of Catawba County, and agreed to transmit that list to the State Board. The Board also unanimously approved the implementation plan for early voting for the primary and general elections for 2009, and passed resolutions for each election designating precincts to have open for both the primary for Ward 4 in the Hickory Municipal Election and for the November election.

Larry Brewer reported that a grant has become available for additional curbside voting signs, so the Catawba County Board of Elections will be applying for funds under that grant.

The Board members and Larry Brewer discussed the State Board meeting scheduled in Raleigh for September 1 and 2.

The Board unanimously approved the dates and times for Board meetings prior to the October primary election as follows: September 15, September 22, and September 29 all at 8:15 a.m., with the last meeting before the October 6 election date taking place on October 5 at 5 p.m.

The remaining absentee ballot applications as shown in the attached document were approved unanimously. The Board considered a complaint received by Shawn Clark, who is a declared candidate for District Attorney for the 2010 election. He complained to the county office about a flyer received for a campaign golf event for the James Gaither campaign. He also complained to Larry Brewer about county employees removing certain signs from property across the street from the Courthouse and Jail. Brewer talked to another county employee, and determined that county employees were ordinarily not to remove campaign signs. In addition, since the District Attorney race would be handled through the State Board of Elections as a multi-county election, Larry Brewer referred the matter to the State Board of Elections who determined that there was no campaign finance problem with the golf tournament flyer received from the Gaither campaign. David Hood agreed to call Shawn Clark to talk to him about that determination.
