### CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Meeting called to order at 8:15 A.M. Chairman David Hood, Secretary Barry Cheney, Member Stephen Palmer and Director Amanda Duncan present.

Duncan presented the recommended budget expenditures for 2017-2018 (attached). Numbers were incomplete because staff wages have not been approved at this time.

Anticipate that costs of ballots will come down as they move to digital formats.

SBOE has not certified any systems at this point. Testing 3 systems. Deadline is in June.

Per Diem line item is assuming 4 BOE members.

Board approved numbers for line items that we have at this point. Still need to get numbers for wages.

Discussed need for purchasing/renting laptops. Duncan informed Board that laptops are starting to fail. Duncan presented to Mick Berry that we rent 87 computers for November election. Berry asked if we could lower that number to 40. Currently have 92 functioning computers, need 87. Board suggested that we rent only 20. This was agreed to.

April 20th, 5:30 P.M. the League of Women Voters is holding a presentation at Newton library "Ensuring Election Integrity". LWV requested Duncan to attend. Duncan extended invitation to Board members.

Duncan presented BOE Statement of Purpose. (attached)

Discussed candidate for new Democratic Board member. Board unanimously feels that having a BOE member who also sits on the Democratic State Executive Committee could portray an image of partisanship. Cheney will relay our decision to the candidate.

## **BOARD OF ELECTIONS**

### **Fiscal Year 2017/2018**

#### **Statement of Purpose**

The goal of the Board of Elections Office is to organize, conduct, and to provide well-planned and managed elections with immediate results. Board of Election will ensure the citizens of Catawba County the right to vote in fair, honest, and impartial elections in accordance with State and Federal Elections law and County regulations, and provide easy access for all registered voters.

#### **Outcomes**

1. Seek opportunities to provide election and registration information before the November and May elections for populations with lower engagement or access, including high school students and individuals served by Meals on Wheels.
2. Generate a more diverse pool (race, gender, age, and language skills) of applicants to serve as poll workers for County elections.

## MINUTES OF MAY 8, 2017

### CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Meeting called to order at 8:15 A.M. Chairman David Hood, Secretary Barry Cheney, Member Stephen Palmer and Director Amanda Duncan present.

Budget for FY 2017 was presented by Duncan. Discussion followed. Duncan requested total of \$770,420. Budget office recommended \$634,118. Assumed amount approved is \$640,342. Amount requested was artificially inflated due to a possible Federal election for Congress in 2017, based on a court opinion as of that time, but which now is not going to happen.

All employees to receive minimum of 3% raise, may qualify for 4% depending upon performance review. Office has been approved to rent 20 laptop computers for May of 2018 election. Cost is \$2,000. Cost for Part-time wages were questioned by Budget. Duncan provided data to show that Catawba County has lower numbers than surrounding counties for Part-time help.

Debra Bechtel has reviewed maintenance contract with ES&S. She approved contract. Will sign a five-year contract with them.

Cheney moved to approve budget, unanimously approved by Board.

Reviewed Town of Maiden's resolution for mixed beverage election to be placed on ballot of November 7, 2017 general election. To read: **To permit the sale of mixed beverages in hotels, restaurants, private clubs, community theaters, and convention centers.**

Resolution was approved by Board.

Discussion of MATs (Multiple Assistant Teams). Office will conduct training May 16th at 10:00 and 14:00. 16 individuals have signed up at this time, 9 Democrats, 6 Republicans and 1 Independent. Board and Duncan agree this will be sufficient number to conduct business. Numbers were increased from last year due to SBOE rule change that does not allow staff personnel to participate in MATs.

Board approved minutes from 3/24/17 meeting.

Duncan relayed that April 20th League of Women presentation at Newton Library went well. CBOE will take over duty of conducting registration drives in schools, previously done by LWV. Duncan is in process of meeting with all city and town managers. Will also meet with school superintendents.

## MINUTES OF AUGUST 10, 2017

### CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Meeting called to order at 8:20 A.M. Chairman David Hood, Secretary Barry Cheney, Member Stephen Palmer and Director Amanda Duncan present. A number of guests were also in attendance.

Discussion of One-Stop sites and times for the October 10, 2017 City of Hickory Primary election.

The schedules will remain the same as previous similar elections.

Some precincts will be combined due to low voter turnout, as done in previous elections:

Pcts. 7 and 34 will be combined with Pct. 35.

Pct. 17 " " Pct. 26.

Pct. 19 " " Pct. 13.

Pct. 23 and 24 " " Pct. 4.

Pct. 29 " " Pct. 30.

Voters in affected precincts will be notified by mail.

Board unanimously approved plan. Resolution of Transfer was signed by Hood.

Discussion of One-Stop sites and times for the November 7, 2017 Municipal election.

Newton and Highland Rec Centers will be open. City of Hickory will reimburse BOE for cost of operating Highland site.

Some precincts will be combined:

Precinct 9 will be combined with Pct. 20.

Precincts 23 and 24 will be combined with Pct. 4.

Precincts 27 will be combined with Pct. 6.

Precincts 29 will be combined with Pct. 30.

Plan was unanimously approved by Board. Resolution of Transfer was signed by Hood.

Discussion of question: Can a voting member of a political party's Executive Committee serve as an election judge if they resign the position on election day?

The consensus opinion was that although election law may not preclude such behavior, doing so would violate the intent of the law and could present an appearance of a conflict of interest. Therefore, the Board would not approve of such activity.

Discussion of request from Mary Burkeholder. As a member of the League of Women Voters, she will be going into schools to help students complete voter registration forms. She wishes to present herself as representing the CCBOE. Board expressed concern that if she were to present incorrect

information, it may present a liability to the BOE. Board agreed that as she is not an employee nor a Board member, that this would be unwise. Duncan will inform her of decision.

Equipment update: No SBOE is in effect at this time to certify equipment, so nothing can be purchased. Testing will be done in May, 2018. Therefore, the office will need to obtain Ballot-on-demand until certified equipment is available.

Newton/Conover and Hickory School Board filing begins Friday August 18th at noon.

Next meeting to be held August 22nd.

Hand-to-eye recount was done on Precincts 23 and 30 on October 11th. No change in results.

Recount completed Thursday, October 12th. Precinct 14 had a voter place a blank ballot into DS-200. Judges opened box, retrieved ballot, voter marked ballot and returned to DS-200. Therefore, number of voters was 1 greater than ballots. SBOE will be informed. Three judges who were involved will be reminded that this was incorrect procedure, and this event will be used in training as an example of what not to do.

Board signed tapes from results of tabulation from 5 Civilian and 1 Military. Also signed tapes of results from 22 Provisional ballots. As a result, total votes cast went from 3,912 before addition of 5 Civilian, 1 Military and 22 Provisional, to 3,940. Votes from Burke County will be added to these totals to achieve the final results. As of now, Burke County has reported 6 votes for Will Locke and 4 votes for Lou Wetmore. The gap between Hank Guess and Lou Wetmore has narrowed from 23 to 20 votes.

Delivery of voting equipment had been scheduled for tomorrow, October 17th. Cannot do this until equipment has been tested, but need ballots to test. Printelect should deliver coding this afternoon, media will be burned tonight. ES&S should deliver ballots tomorrow morning.

Mock election scheduled for tomorrow will not be done. Will be re-scheduled to later date.

Newton and Hickory One Stop sites will open on Thursday, October 18th.

Previous meeting minutes: Minutes of 9/19/17 were amended to clarify language regarding Kimberly Walker. Approved minutes from 9/19, 9/26, 10/3, 10/9 and 10/10.

Discussion of personnel, need to hire temporary worker for early 2018, January until May. No decision was made.

Political Action Committee has formed for a write-in candidate in the Newton Mayor race, Jan Herman.

Meeting is scheduled for tomorrow morning, but expect no business to transact. Therefore, all Board members will participate via telephone.

Ms. Duncan:

I am writing to make you aware of a question and concerns regarding the City of Hickory mayoral election and the campaigning efforts of one of the candidates. I am a volunteer with Will Locke's campaign, but am writing on my own behalf as a life-long citizen of Hickory.

Hank Guess' campaign had automated, recorded phone calls sent to Hickory resident mobile phones last week; I was made aware of these calls starting last Friday (11/3). This message was recorded from Mike Johnson, endorsing Hank Guess and encouraging people to vote for Hank. I received one of these recorded calls on my mobile number, as well as at least 6 other people I have spoken to. I have a recorded version of the message if you would like for me to send it to you.

First off, FCC regulations state that automated recorded calls ("robocalls") are not to be placed to mobile phone numbers during a political campaign. In my experience with the Locke campaign, I know that they have specifically avoided using "robocalls" to mobile numbers due to this FCC regulation.

Secondly, the recorded message did not include a phone number for the recipient to use to call with any questions or to request information. It is my understanding that any recorded "robocall", regardless of if it's to landline or mobile numbers, are required to include a phone number in any recording to provide the voter with a means for communicating with the campaign.

And finally, the recorded message also indicated that Early Voting would be taking place from 8:00am until 12:00pm on Saturday, November 4th, instead of the actual voting hours of 8:00am to 1:00pm. This misinformation may lead some people to not come out to Early Voting between 12:00pm and 1:00pm on Saturday if they believe the polling location was not open during that hour.

Overall, I am concerned about the use of these automated recorded messages with missing or incorrect information to a large number of mobile phone numbers by the Guess campaign. As you can imagine, with many more people using their mobile phones for communications as opposed to landline numbers having one campaign break the rules and make high-volume, automated recorded calls to mobile numbers while the other follows the proper guidelines creates an unfair advantage.

I wanted to make you aware of my concerns, and ask if there are any exceptions I am not aware of that allowed the Guess campaign to use these automated calls to mobile numbers in this manner.

If there are not, I would like to make sure the Catawba County Board of Elections is aware of these issues.
