**A RESOLUTION AMENDING CATAWBA COUNTY'S EARLY VOTING IMPLEMENTATION PLAN
FOR MARCH 2026 PRIMARY AS IT RELATES TO THE HOURS OF OPERATION
DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER**


- WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 163-166.35, the county board of elections is responsible for adopting an early voting implementation plan establishing the hours of operation for each early voting site; and
- WHEREAS, on November 14, 2025, by motion in unanimous approval, the Catawba County Board of Elections adopted an Early Voting Implementation Plan for the March 2026 Primary for Catawba County; and
- WHEREAS, on December 19, 2025, the North Carolina State Board of Elections approved the Catawba County Board of Elections Early Voting Implementation Plan for the March 2026 Primary for Catawba County; and
- WHEREAS, the Catawba County Board of Elections wishes to amend the hours of operation of the early voting sites due to inclement weather in the Catawba County Board of Elections Early Voting Implementation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Catawba County Board of Elections as follows:

1. That the Catawba County Board of Elections Early Voting Implementation Plan for the March 2026 Primary be amended to state that if Catawba County closes or operates on a delayed schedule due to inclement weather, each early voting site will follow Catawba County's directive.
2. The Director of the Board of Elections is responsible for communicating any delays or closings to the personnel operating the early voting sites and notify the public as soon as possible upon receiving the information from Catawba County.
3. That this Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
