To: All Potential Respondents

The Request for Proposals (RFP) is modified as set forth in this Addendum No. 1. The original RFP documents and any previously issued addenda remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Addendum, which is hereby made part of the RFP. Respondent shall take this Addendum into consideration when preparing and submitting its Bid Response. Catawba County is issuing this Addendum to provide RFP clarifications.

Questions/Clarifications:

1. **Question:** Does Catawba County have any disposal restrictions / requirements?

Answer: For our events, waste is restricted to residential-only, no business waste is allowed. In addition, we do not allow explosives or ammunition of any kind. Disposal contractor must apply for a temporary event permit with NCDEQ before the event and submit an event collections report after.

2. **Question:** How many personnel have you had performing your events in the past contract period?

Answer: Our past contractors typically bring a team of around 15 people. We prefer to have a team large enough to accommodate several drop-off locations along the event route, such as 3 stops for HHW and 1-2 stops for electronics. Catawba County and partnering municipalities will usually provide an accessory team of about 20 volunteers to help direct traffic, collect non-hazardous items, and conduct surveys.

3. **Question:** Do you require a minimum number of personnel to perform each event?

Answer: The number of contractor personnel will be determined based on site location and route plan, but typically lies between 15-20 people.

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
