Cooking Safely in the Microwave

- Arrange food items evenly in a microwave safe covered dish and add some liquid if needed.
- Cover the dish with a lid or plastic wrap.
- Loosen or vent the lid or plastic wrap to let steam escape. The moist heat that is created will help destroy harmful bacteria and ensure uniform cooking.
- Stir or rotate food midway through the microwaving time to eliminate cold spots where harmful bacteria can survive, and for more even cooking.
