- Call the main office at 828-695-5610 if a client is not answering the door. We will call the client and/or the emergency contacts to try to locate the client.
- Please **avoid** returning to the site with a meal if at all possible. If your last scheduled delivery is not home, please deliver the extra meal to another registered client by returning to your previous stop or going back to the first client on your route (if it is close to the pick up location), as your time and schedule allow.
- Please **return to the pickup/drop-off location immediately after your delivery.** Most sites consist of community volunteers who are only there waiting for your return; so we ask that you be respectful of their time.
- **No weapons** are allowed on your person or in your vehicle while delivering. This is a county policy and can be found in the handbook.
