

CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Minutes of meeting held on February 18, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 8:15 a.m. Members Cheney, Yang, Hood, and Abernethy, and the Director, were present. The minutes from February 11, 2020 were approved.

One OVR application and 71 CIV applications were approved. The additional OS (one-stop) absentee ballots received were approved; a total of 2310 one-stop ballots have been cast as of yesterday.


The Director reported that several Balotar printers at the one-stop voting sites have jammed. These were replaced by printers at the Board office. Ballot paper is the suspected cause. The smoke alarm at the Conover site sounded at closing time on February 13, 2020. Someone stole that precinct's curbside alert device.

One candidate did not file a campaign finance report as of the deadline. Further actions with respect to this are the responsibility of the State Board.
