

# CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

## Minutes of meeting held on March 12, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 8:18 a.m. Members Cheney, Hood, Abernethy, and White, and the Director, were present. The minutes from March 2 and March 3, 2020, were approved.

Forty-five CIV, six OVR, and two MIL supplemental absentee applications were approved. Seven were not approved; six being untimely, and one having no signature.


One hundred seventeen provisional ballots were researched by the staff. Of these, sixty-four were approved and fifty-two were not approved, in accordance with staff recommendations. One was still pending, as the voter has until five o'clock today to submit identification.

Applications are being received by the county human resources staff for the vacant board of elections staff position.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:40 a.m. A bipartisan team consisting of Mr. Cheney and Mr. Abernethy worked in the Conference Room until 8:50 a.m. marking six OVR and two MIL ballots in accordance with voter instructions received by telefax.

The next meeting will be tomorrow's county canvass of the primary election.
