

# CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

## Minutes of meeting held on November 12, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 8:15 a.m. Members Cheney, White, Hood, and Abernethy were present. The Director was present. The minutes from November 3, 2020 were approved.

The purpose of the meeting was to approve supplemental and provisional ballots from the 2020 general election.

The board approved 143 provisional ballots in full, and 18 in part, as recommended by the staff after performing research. Board members reviewed the 274 which were not recommended for approval, and these were not approved. Reasons for disapproval included not being registered, being untimely registered, and residing outside of the county.

Approved were a total of 472 CIV applications, which included 19 which were cured by voter affidavit. Also approved were 18 OVR and 30 MIL applications, for a sum of 520 approved ballots. These were fed into tabulators. The tabulators were not closed, as some applications may be received later today.

The four applications which were disapproved as not having a timely postmark were CIV 14700, 14198, 12274, and 13439.

The four applications which were disapproved because the voter voted at the polls on election day were CIV 14148, 14656, 14147, and 2844. These the board voted to send to the State Board of Elections for investigation.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:22 a.m. The canvass is to take place tomorrow at 11:00 a.m.
