

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
December 1, 2021

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15am. The board then unanimously approved the minutes from the November 9, 2021 meeting. Amanda Duncan presented a proposed One-Stop plan for the implementation of early voting for the 2022 Primary election, which passed unanimously. She then informed the board that part-time employees for the Primary election would include Donna Jones, whose husband's nephew is planning to run for County Commissioner. No board member had objection, given that her job duties will be ministerial instead of discretionary. Duncan also informed the board that Sue Laney would also be a part time employee, after stepping down from the Clerk's office and that Barbara Morris would also be a part time employee even though she has recently retired from working at the County Clerk in conjunction with the Board of Commissioners. No board member had objection.

With no other items of business, Board Chair Cheney adjourned the meeting.
