

CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Minutes of meeting held on July 20, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 8:25 a.m., after the members were sworn in for their two-year terms by District Court Judge Sherri W. Elliott. Members Cheney, White, Hood, Culbreath-Setzer, and Abernethy were present. The Director was present. The minutes from May 5, 2021 were approved.

Abernethy moved that David W. Hood be appointed Secretary, which was unanimously approved. The members then reviewed and signed the Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement and reviewed a Notice Regarding Social Media received from the State Board of Elections.

A written list of Director Duties was reviewed and adopted unanimously. The board then reviewed and approved unanimously a proposed One Stop Early Voting schedule for the upcoming Municipal elections, which calls for the Newton site only. The usual Hickory site is usually paid for by the City of Hickory, and with elections for Hickory and Long View having been postponed until 2022, there is no money in the budget for a second site.

Chair Barry Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
