

MINUTES OF  
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
AUGUST 17, 2021

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order. Member Culbreath-Setzer was not present. The Board unanimously approved the minutes from the July 20, 2021 meeting. The Board then unanimously approved the appointment of all the precinct judges proposed by Director Amanda Duncan. Director Amanda Duncan requested the Board to approve a permanent move of voting location in Precinct 6 from the Claremont Town Hall to the First Baptist Church, which was approved unanimously.

The Board then considered the Director's proposed temporary transfer of voting location for certain voters for the November 2021 municipal election, which was unanimously approved. The September 28 meeting of the Board was cancelled because there will not be sufficient business to conduct, so the next scheduled meeting of the Board will be October 5.

The Board then had a discussion about how maintenance of the voting list is done. Every January after a federal election in a previous November, the Board follows state law in verifying the status of voters who have not voted in a certain number of elections. In addition, periodic changes to the voting rolls are made either at the state or local level based upon notification of voter deaths, voter address changes, or changes in voter felony status.

With no other items of business, Board Chair Cheney adjourned the meeting.
