

MINUTES OF  
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
July 19, 2022

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15am. Member Luckadoo was not present. The minutes from the July 12, 2022 meeting were adopted unanimously.

The following absentee ballots applications were unanimously approved: (28) Absentee by Mail Ballots and (280) One-Stop Absentee Ballots. Please see the attached documents. The Board authorized the staff to feed approved ballots into the designated tabulator after approval, with tabulation not to be initiated until election day.


Amanda Duncan reported that a felon had appealed our staff refusal to register that felon to vote. Duncan plans to send a letter to the person stating that while registration to vote right now is prohibited, that will no longer be true as of July 27, 2022 so long as the felon is not incarcerated.

The Board unanimously approved Duncan's proposal to have Chief Judges return the precinct results to the Board office on Election Night of July 26, 2022 rather than using runners.

In response to a question from the Board Chair, Amanda Duncan reported that she had reviewed the approximately 100 signatures submitted in Catawba County with respect to the Green Party's drive to be on the November ballot, and that she had seen no discrepancies in the signatures.

Board Chair Cheney adjourned the meeting.
