

MINUTES OF

July 25, 2022


Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 5pm. The minutes from the July 19, 2022 meeting were adopted unanimously.

The following absentee ballots applications were unanimously approved: (7) Absentee by Mail Ballots, (1) Overseas ballot (the votes from which were transferred to a ballot suitable for tabulation) and (355) One-Stop Absentee Ballots. Please see the attached documents. The Board authorized the staff to feed approved ballots into the designated tabulator after approval, with tabulation not to be initiated until election day.

Marvin Bentley reported that one mail-in absentee came in without any witness signatures, so the Board disapproved that one. Staff has tried to contact the voter so that the person can vote on election day instead.

Board Chair Cheney adjourned the meeting.
