

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
October 11, 2022


Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15 am. Because he was appearing remotely, he appointed member Jason White to conduct the meeting in person. The minutes from the October 4, 2022 meeting were adopted unanimously.

The following absentee ballots applications were unanimously approved: 143 Civilian and 2 Overseas. See the attached documents. The Board authorized the staff to feed approved ballots into the designated tabulator after approval, with tabulation not to be initiated until election day. Three civilian ballots had to be remarked because stray marks were preventing proper reading by the tabulator – this was accomplished by members Hood, White, Luckadoo, and Culbreath-Setzer.

Director Amanda Duncan reported about the plans in place to prepare for the opening of early voting sites next week.

Board member Jason White then adjourned the meeting.
