


MINUTES OF  
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
November 1, 2022

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:17 am. The minutes from the October 25, 2022 meeting were adopted unanimously.

The following absentee ballots applications were unanimously approved: 11,006 One-Stop, 341 Civilian, 3 Military and 5 Overseas. See the attached documents. The Board authorized the staff to feed approved ballots into the designated tabulator after approval, with tabulation not to be initiated until election day. Five civilian ballots had to be remarked because they could not be read by the tabulator, and one was marked for a visually impaired voter pursuant to the legally-prescribed procedure. This was all accomplished by Board members in bipartisan teams. Regarding the previously received request received to reconsider the link to vote411.org on the Board of Elections website, this issue was deferred until the Canvass on November 18.

Board Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
