

MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
November 8, 2022

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

The Board unanimously voted to close the DS 200 Tabulators and to begin to tabulate the absentee and one-stop ballots. Upon completion, the Board all reviewed the abstracts of those results and certified them for delivery to the State Board of Elections and to the Clerk of Superior Court.

Director Duncan reported that one mail-in absentee voter, Gwendolyn Kingsley, has apparently passed away after the Board accepted her absentee ballot. This is based on reporting from the State. The procedure is for the Board to challenge that absentee ballot, so the Board unanimously decided to pursue that challenge. A hearing will take place on November 18 at the Canvass, with notice of that hearing to be sent to the voter's address.

Board Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
