


MINUTES OF
CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
October 25, 2022

Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15 am. The minutes from the October 18, 2022 meeting were adopted unanimously.

The following absentee ballots applications were unanimously approved: 7603 One-Stop, 228 Civilian, 3 Military and 4 Overseas. See the attached documents. The Board authorized the staff to feed approved ballots into the designated tabulator after approval, with tabulation not to be initiated until election day. Six civilian ballots had to be remarked because stray marks were preventing proper reading by the tabulator – this was accomplished by members Hood, Luckadoo, Culbreath-Setzer and White. A request received to reconsider the link to vote411.org on the Board of Elections website was tabled given the absence of Director Amanda Duncan.

Board Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
