Board Chair Barry Cheney called the meeting to order at 8:15am. All members were present in-person except for Tommy Luckadoo who appeared by phone.

The minutes from the October 3 meeting were unanimously approved.


The Board unanimously approved the following absentee ballot applications for the November election: CIV 6 and OS 315. Please see the attached documents.

Director Amanda Duncan reported that logic and accuracy testing for the DS300 machines the Board is proposing the County purchase shall take place on October 23, 2023 at 9am. A copy of the previously approved resolution of the Board to the County Commissioners was also distributed to all Board members.

Duncan proposed that she contact the City of Newton to see if they would publicize early voting on their electronic billboard, which all Board members approved. Duncan also reported that Common Cause and the local League of Women Voters want to do a joint program about election law changes, as voter information prior to the March primary. The Board unanimously agreed that this program, put on by those two organizations, can be hosted at the Board of Elections office.

There being no other items of business, Board Chair Cheney then adjourned the meeting.
